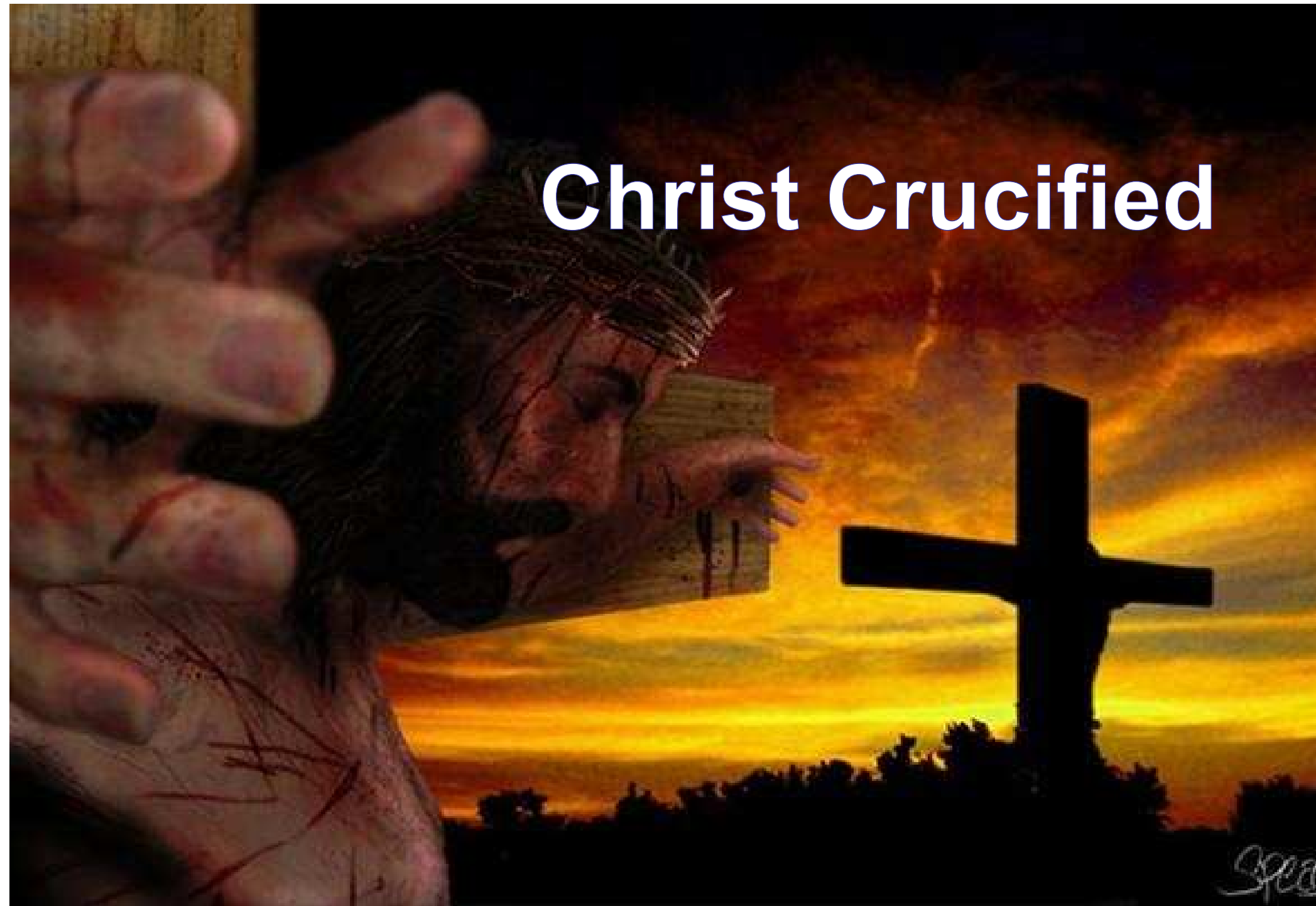

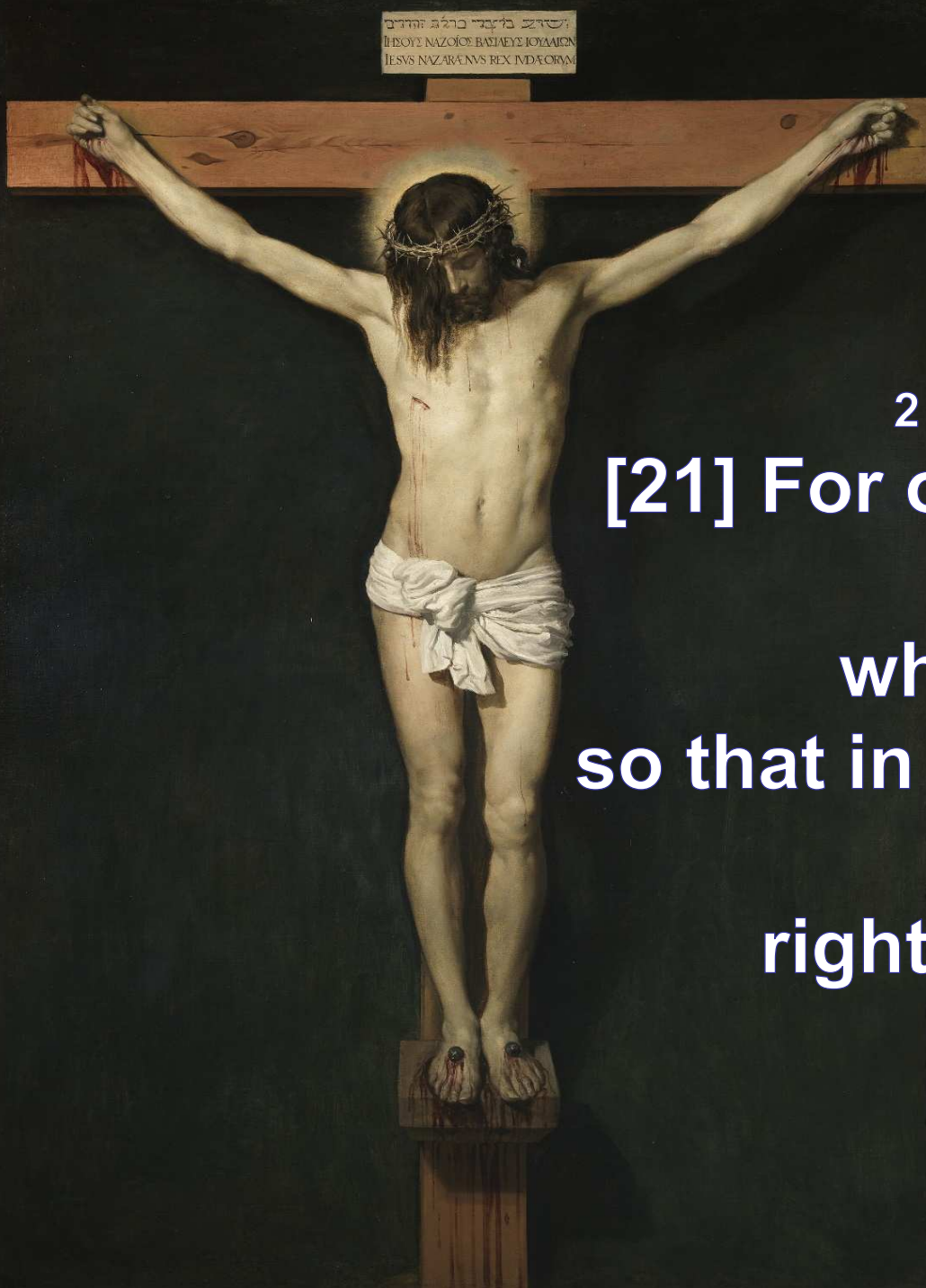

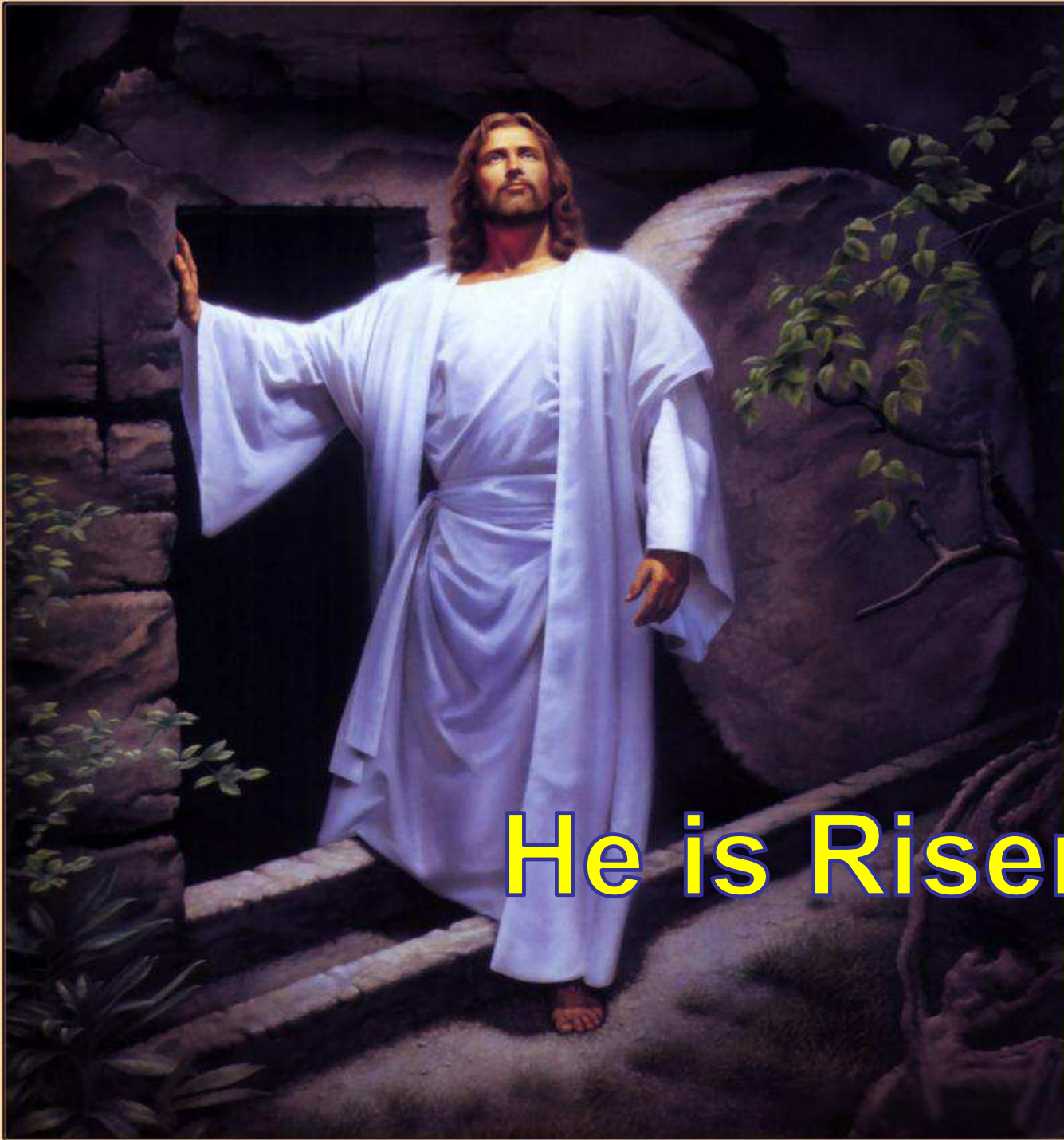

God should be number one.

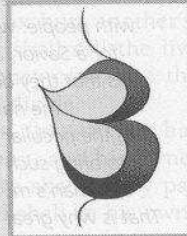


2. You shall not make yourself any graven image.

Don't neglect the things of God.

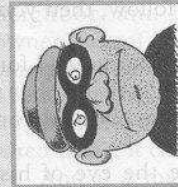
5. Honor your father and your mother.

7. You shall not commit adultery

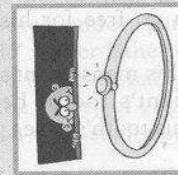
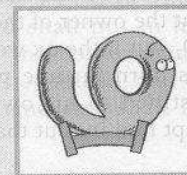
Adultery leaves a heart broken.

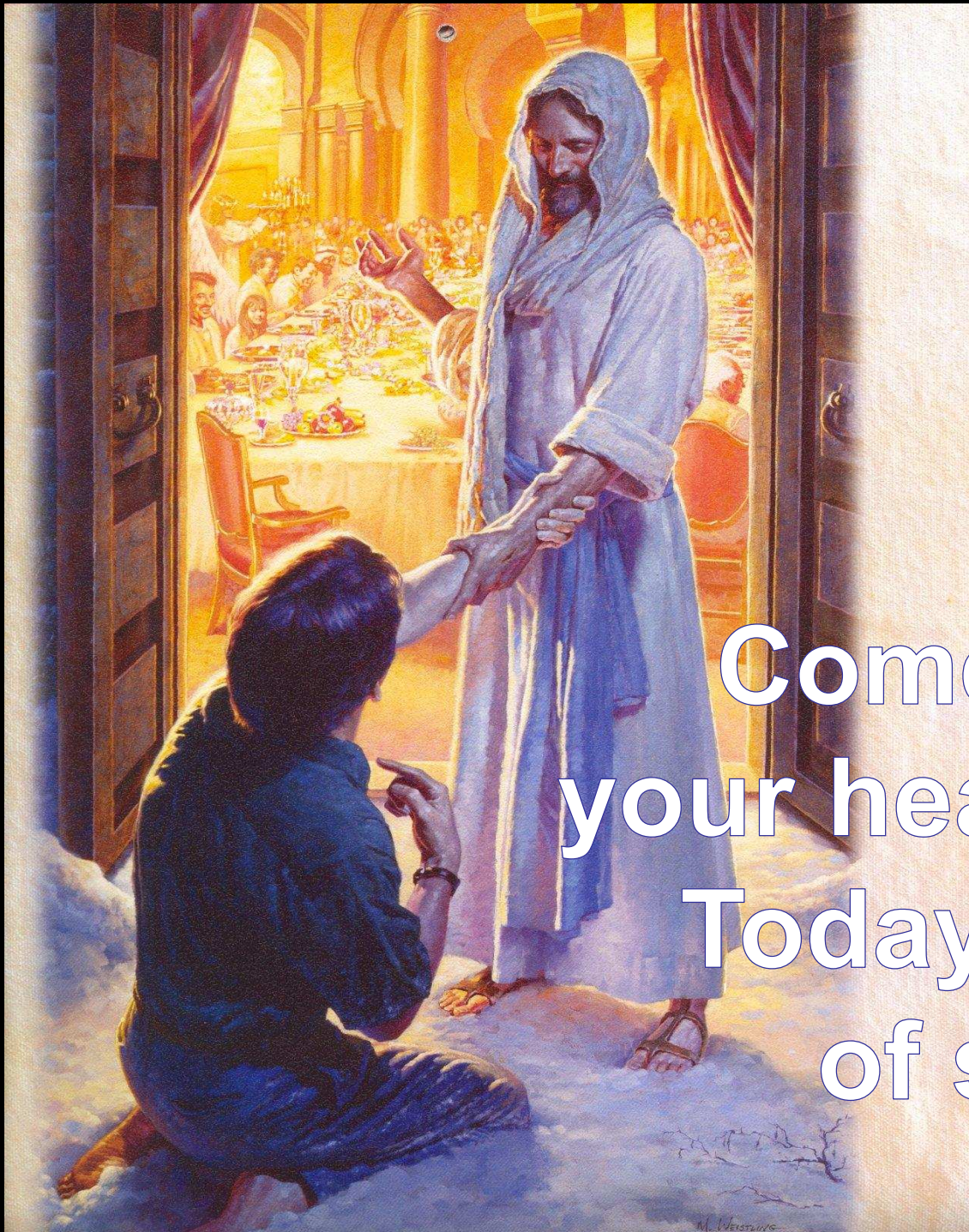

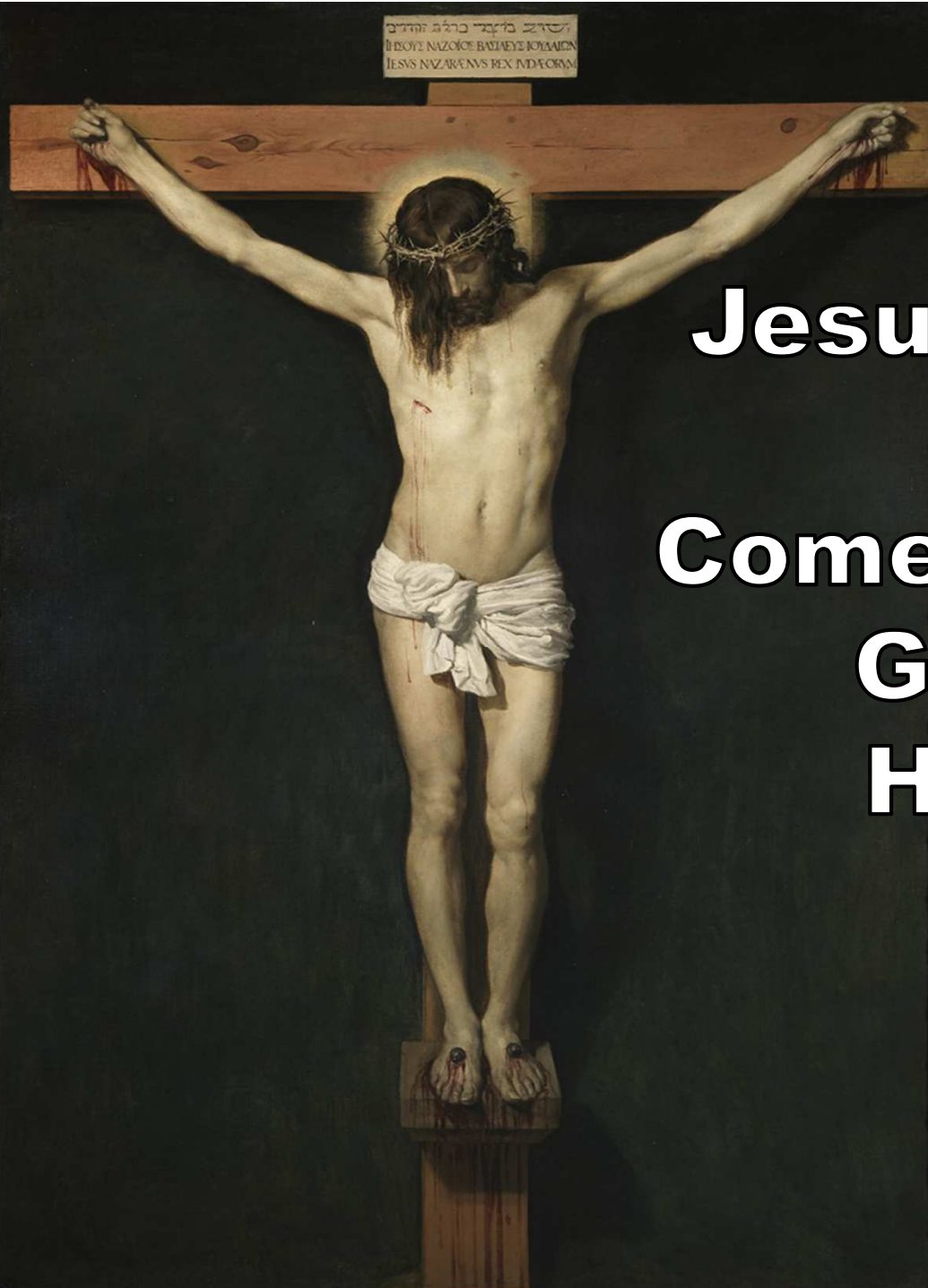


